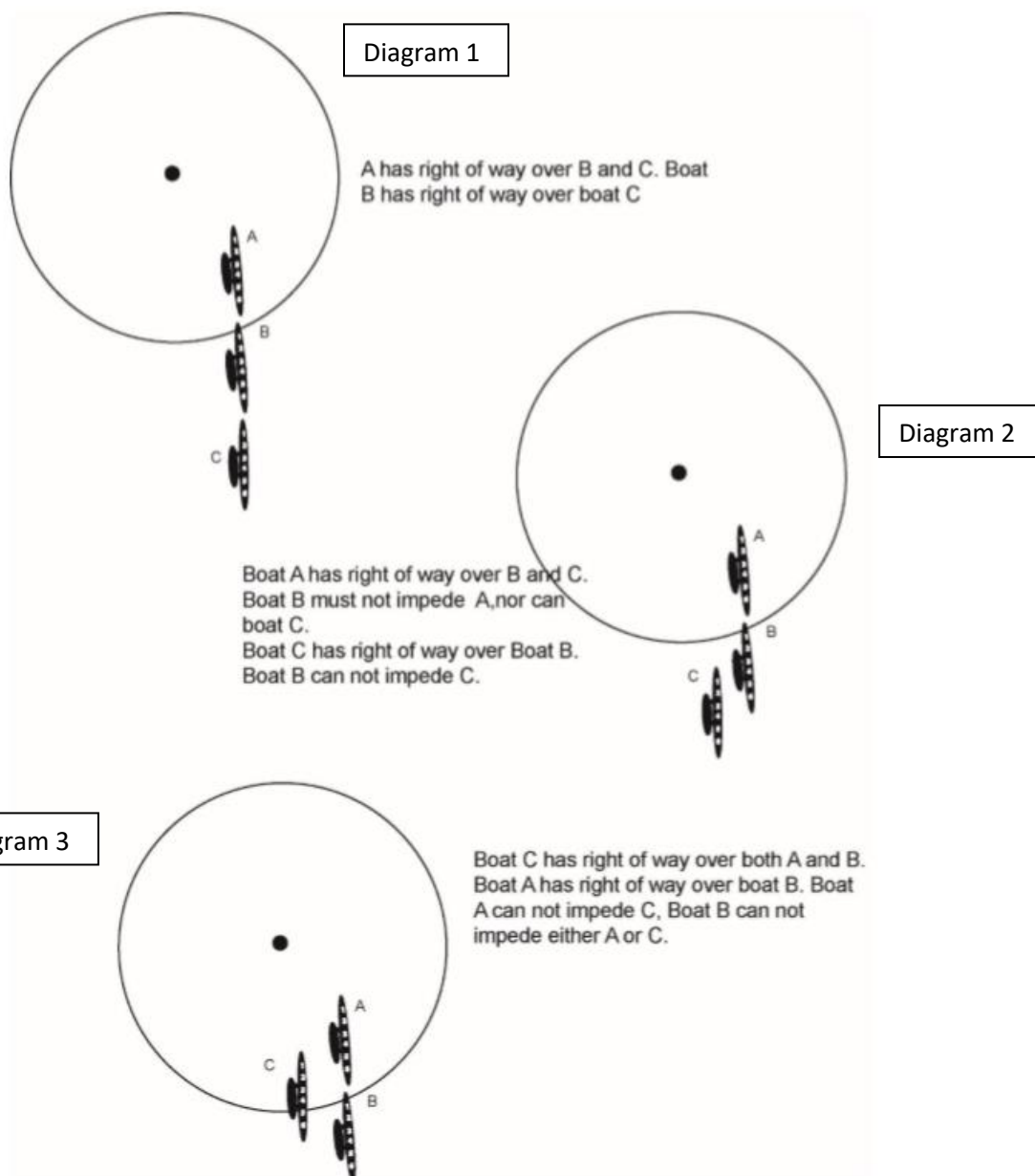


## Turning and Overlap

“Overlap” is defined as a condition that exists when no open water can be seen between the stern of one canoe and the bow of another, when canoes are viewed at right angles to their course.

“Turning Circle” is defined as an area encircling an obstacle, float or marker with a radius of two (2) boat lengths with the obstacle, float or marker at the center



\*note in diagram 3 above C only has right of way once they enter the circle area.
